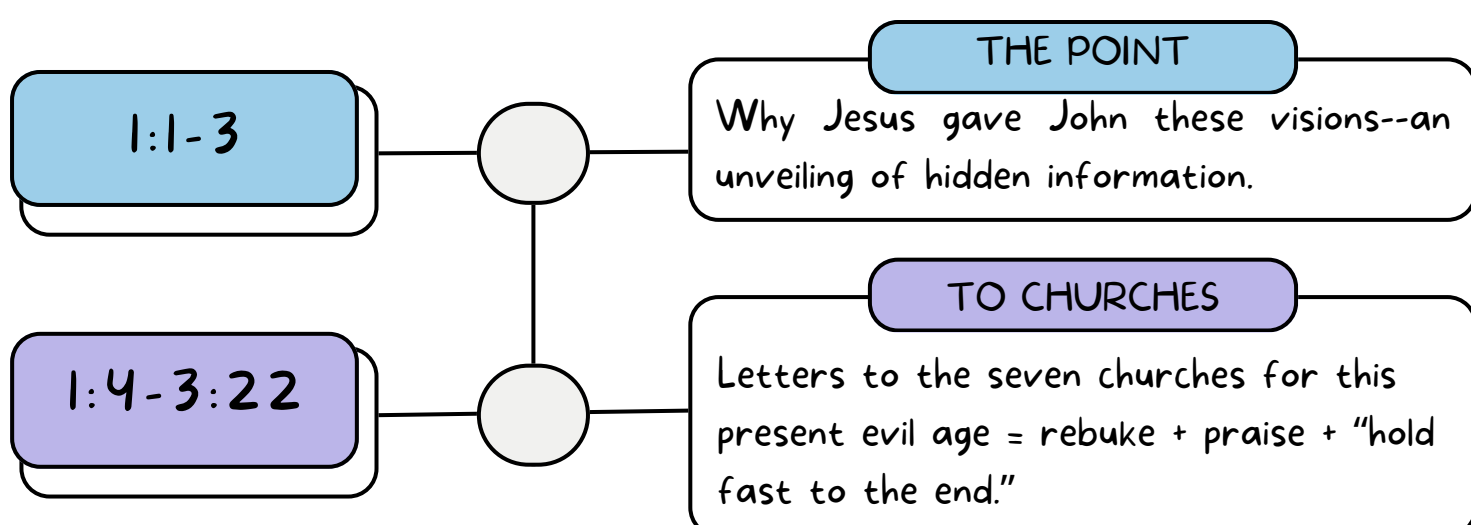
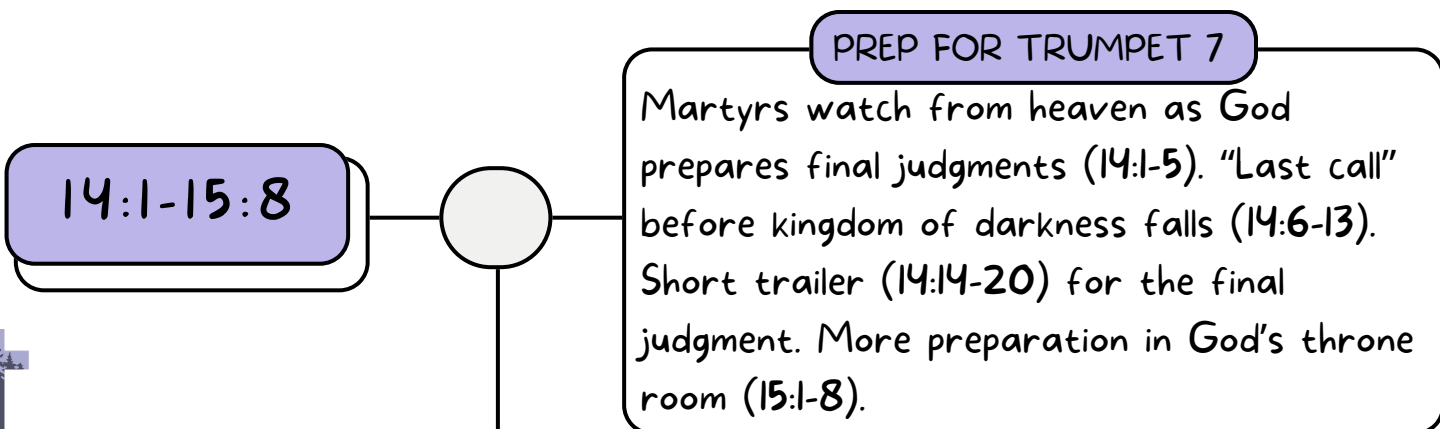
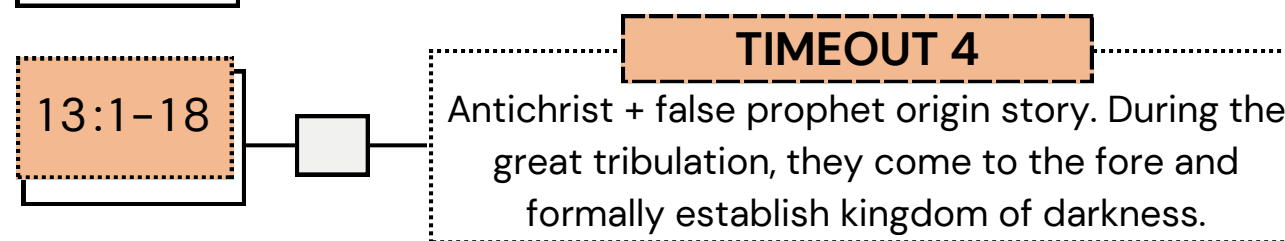
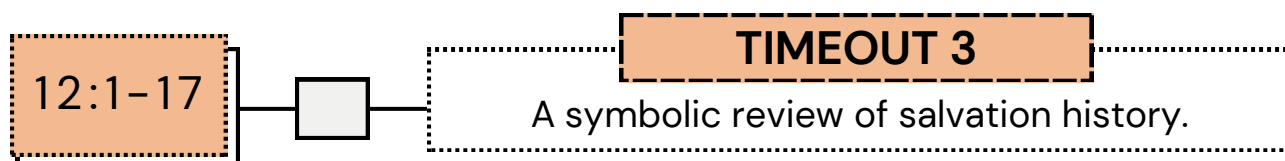
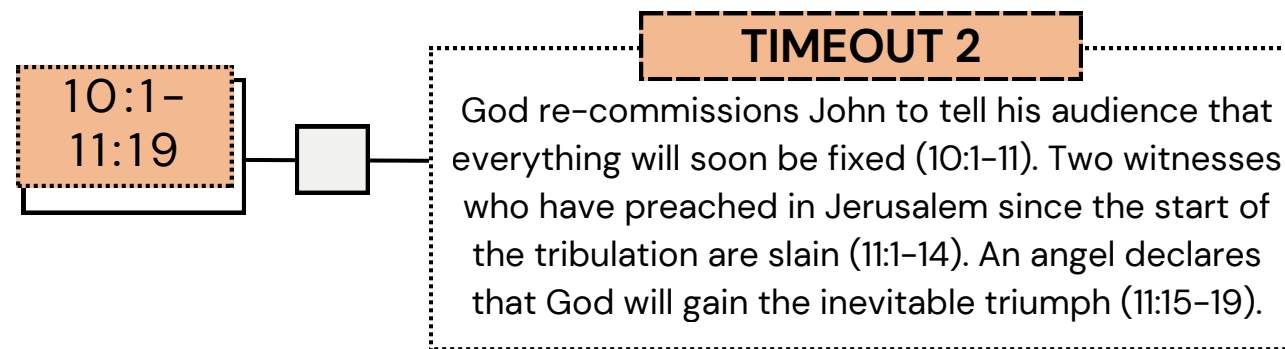
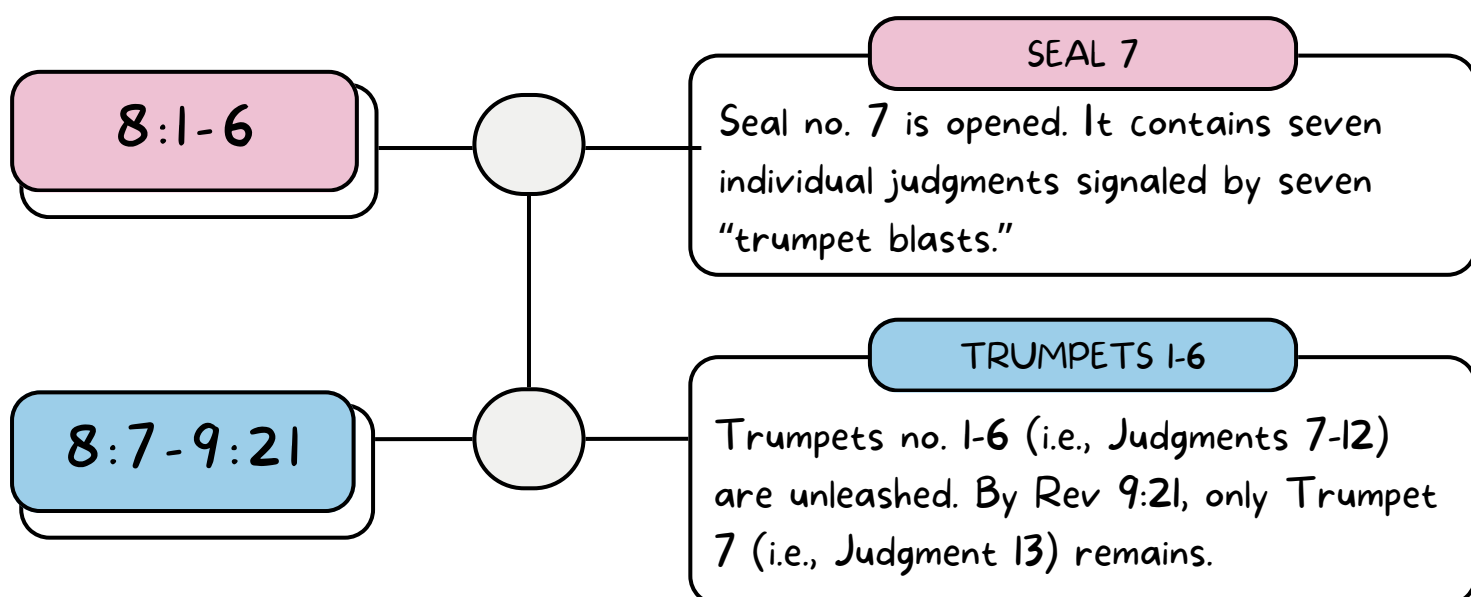
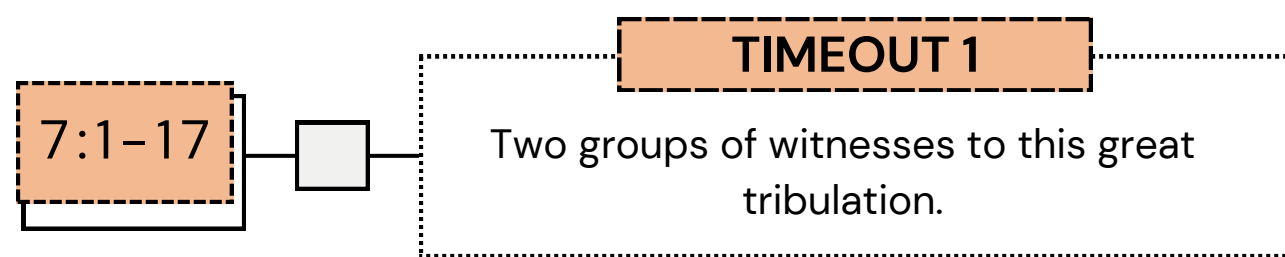
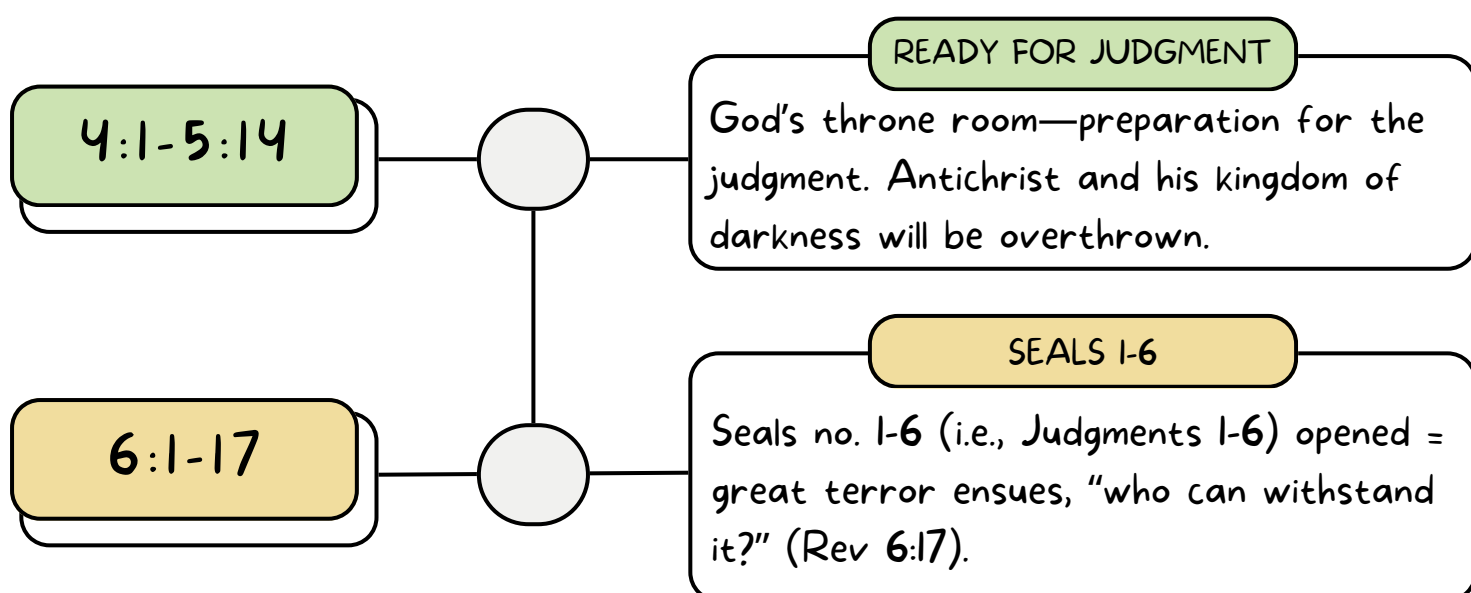




OUTLINE of the Book of Revelation!



Seals, Trumpets, and Bowls—Oh, My! (4:1 - 16:21)



16:1-21

TRUMPET 7

Trumpet 7 is triggered, which is comprised of seven "bowls" of wrath that angels pour out onto the earth (Judgments 13-19). The kingdom of evil is now destroyed.

Game Over (17:1 - 22:21)

17:1-18:24

GOODBYE, DARKNESS

A doubling back to show us the impact of Bowls 1-7 (i.e., Trumpet 7 and Judgments 13-19, above) on Antichrist's evil kingdom of darkness ("Babylon").

19:1-10

HALLELUJAH!

Rejoicing in heaven because God has now destroyed the kingdom of darkness.

19:11-21

HE'S BAAACK!

Jesus returns with his angels to defeat the now-weakened Antichrist, whose kingdom was destroyed by Trumpet 7 (in Rev 17:1 - 18:24). Jesus casts him and the false prophet into hell.

20:1-6

THE MILLENNIUM

Jesus begins his 1,000 year reign as king over Israel. Satan is imprisoned in the abyss, all believers are resurrected.

20:7-10

BYE, BYE SATAN

Satan's final rebellion once he is released from the abyss, at the end of Jesus' 1,000 reign. He raises an army, marches on Jerusalem, and is defeated. Satan is cast into the lake of fire.

20:11-15

THE JUDGMENT

Unbelievers are resurrected. Jesus judges all people and casts non-believers into the lake of fire (cp. Mt 25:31-46).

21:1-22:9

THE NEW CREATION

"Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away ... And He who sits on the throne said, 'Behold, I am making all things new'" (Rev 21:1, 5).

22:10-21

FINAL MESSAGE

"The Spirit and the bride say, 'Come.' And let the one who hears say, 'Come.' And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires, take the water of life without cost" (Rev 22:17).
